JUDGMENT

Appellants David C. Baldinelli and Kelli Doan-Baldinelli appeal from the district court's judgment entered on April 18, 2017, in favor of appellees U.S. Bank Trust, N.A., as Trustee for LSF9 Mater Participation Trust, and Caliber Home Loans, Inc. Having reviewed the record and the parties' arguments on appeal, we agree with the district court that our precedent forecloses the appellants' principal argument on appeal. The remaining appellate arguments fail for lack of sufficient development, *see United States v. Zannino*, 895 F.2d 1, 17 (1st Cir. 1990), or lack of merit, *see Chiang v. Verizon New England Inc.*, 595 F.3d 26, 34 (1st Cir. 2010) (reviewing court can "affirm the district court on any basis apparent in the record"). Accordingly, we affirm the judgment.

The appellants' motion for certification is denied.
